- Harold Corr Oval in Cambridge Park is now closed to the public as ground work commences on our City's first synthetic athletics track.
The highly anticipated Harold Corr Athletics Track Upgrade is a \$5 million project being jointly funded by Council (\$2.8 million), the NSW Government (\$2 million) and the Australian Government (\$303,341).
The first stage will deliver a synthetic athletics track and field facility, floodlighting and a formalised carpark. Once transformed, the facility will benefit athletics clubs and schools. It will also offer more sporting and recreation opportunities for residents and the wider community.
Construction will continue through to the end of the year and into 2022, with the revamped facility set to open in September.
