- if the local authority fails to finally determine the application within 6 weeks after it is made, then the local authority is taken, for the purposes of any appeal proceedings, to have refused the application, and
- if the local authority refuses the application for a certificate of compliance, or is taken to have refused the application, the owner of the premises on which the relevant swimming pool is situated is entitled to appeal to the Land and Environment Court against the local authority's refusal.

FEES & CHARGES

The fees and charges imposed are as prescribed under Section 19 of the Swimming Pools Regulations 2018:

First inspection fee: \$150

Re-inspection fee: \$100 per inspection

Only the first inspection fee is payable on lodgement of the application. If a re-inspection is required, this will be invoiced to the applicant at the time of inspection. Reinspection fees will be imposed for each subsequent inspection carried out.

Please note: Council will not issue a Certificate of Compliance until all fees have been paid.
