# Night work on Great Western Highway and Parker Street intersection, Kingswood from Monday 04 May 2020

The Australian Government is funding a \$200 million Local Roads Package as part of the Western Sydney Infrastructure Plan. Funding has been allocated for Penrith City Council to improve road safety and traffic flow efficiency at key intersections along The Northern Road.

Penrith City Council is upgrading The Northern Road and Great Western Highway intersection. As part of this work, we need to carry out work at night to ensure the safety of workers, pedestrians and motorists and to minimise impact on road users.

### Work schedule

We will be on site working 5 nights per week between **Monday 04 May 2020** and **Thursday 14 May 2020**, Schedule works are subject to weather permitting and road opening permit issued by TfNSW. Our night work hours will be between **8pm to 5am.** Please see below table for night work schedule. Residents will be notified in advance of any changes to the below night work schedule.

## How will the work affect you?

Work may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier tasks in the earliest part of the shift where possible, using non-tonal reversing alarms on heavy vehicles and switching off plant equipment when not in use.

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe for road workers, motorists and pedestrians. Access through the work site will always be maintained.
