- Construction on the \$24 million upgrade to Regatta Park is now underway and the riverbank, from River Road down to the river foreshore, is temporarily closed and the eastern car park is permanently closed to allow the transformation to start.

The first stage of construction will deliver a 112-metre pavilion with undercover play space and water features, a new amenity block, a pathway down to the river foreshore and several over-water viewing platforms.

An adult change facility in the amenities block on the western side of River Road is also being delivered. The car park and amenities block on this side of River Road remains open, as does the Great River Walk.

The construction of Regatta Park is expected to take 18 months, with the project set to be complete in December 2022.
