- Lawson Street in the CBD is temporarily closed to through traffic until Friday, 1 October as part of the Soper Place Revitalisation. These works are taking place in line with the latest Public Health Order.

Essential business traffic can still access the rear entrance of the Henry Lawson Centre from 7am–9pm Monday to Friday and 8.30am–3.30pm on Saturday, but only via Henry Street.
