


COLOUR ME IN!



Tree hollows are important habitat for many native animals including bats, possums, birds, snakes, and antechinus.

Australia is home to over 2,000 native bee species. They have the important job of pollinating plants by collecting nectar and pollen from flowers.

Native plants and animals have evolved to support each other. Plants provide habitat and different food sources like flowers for nectar-feeding birds and fruit for possums.

Spiders are important predators who eat insects!

Did you know that most amphibians have thin, moist skin that helps them breathe?

Snakes are solar-powered and rely fully on external heat sources.

Waterways are very important for plants and animals to survive, and are important ecosystems. They provide habitat, shelter and transportation.

Mammals are divided into three groups: monotremes, marsupials and placentals - all of which have fur, produce milk and are warm-blooded.
