## **Purpose**

The primary purpose of this policy is to provide a framework of guiding principles and decision-making criteria for street performers in the Penrith Local Government Area (LGA). By clarifying expectations, the aim is to foster an environment that encourages and enables a range of high quality street performers to thrive in the city of Penrith.

## **Policy Statement**

The Policy aims to:

- (a) Encourage street performing that will contribute to the vibrancy, liveliness and ambience of Penrith LGA.
- (b) Minimise any potential adverse impacts on nearby businesses, properties or community
- (c) Respect the rights of individuals wishing to express themselves through a popular art form.
- (d) Ensure street performers operate in accordance with their approval in public spaces.
- (e) Provide guidance and assistance for people wanting to perform in public spaces within the Penrith LGA.
- (f) Recognise that street performing is a valid means for artists and performer to make a
- (g) Ensure that street performing does not unduly interfere with pedestrian traffic, conduct of business, community safety and public amenity.

#### Scope

This Policy provides the framework for appropriate street performances within the city of Penrith while acknowledging that in a mixed use environment, this activity must be carefully managed for equity and fairness to all.
