Night work on Derby Street and Parker Street intersection, Kingswood from Tuesday 7 January 2020

The Australian Government is funding a \$200 million Local Roads Package as part of the Western Sydney Infrastructure Plan. Funding has been allocated for Penrith City Council to improve road safety and traffic flow efficiency at key intersections along The Northern Road.

Penrith City Council is upgrading The Northern Road and Derby Street intersection. As part of this work, we need to carry out work at night to ensure the safety of workers, pedestrians and motorists and to minimise impact on road users.

Work schedule

We will be on site for up to **5 night shifts per week** between **Tuesday 7 January 2020** and late **June 2020**, weather permitting. Our night work hours will be between **8pm to 5am**. Please see below table for night work schedule. Residents will be notified in advance of any changes to the below night work schedule.

Work will also continue during standard construction hours from **7am to 6pm** Mondays to Fridays and **8am to 1pm** on Saturdays.

How will the work affect you?

Work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier tasks in the earliest part of the shift where possible, using non-tonal reversing alarms on heavy vehicles and switching off plant equipment when not in use.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe for road workers, motorists and pedestrians. During construction some street parking on Derby Street will be temporarily unavailable. Access through the work site will always be maintained.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and traffic signs. Motorists may experience minor delays due to changed traffic conditions. For the latest traffic updates, you can call 132 701, visit livetraffic.com or download the Live Traffic NSW App.
