Start of work on The Northern Road and Derby Street, Kingswood from Tuesday 8 October

The Australian Government is funding a \$200 million Local Roads Package as part of the Western Sydney Infrastructure Plan. Funding has been allocated for Penrith City Council to improve road safety and traffic flow efficiency at key intersections along The Northern Road.

Penrith City Council will begin work to upgrade the intersection at The Northern Road and Derby Street, Kingswood.

This work will include:

- building new turning lanes by widening Derby Street at The Northern Road intersection
- · upgrading the existing traffic lights
- · relocating public utilities
- building a new stormwater drainage system
- landscaping and new line marking

Work schedule

Work will be carried out between **Tuesday 8 October** and **September 2020** from **7am** to **6pm**, **Mondays** to **Fridays** and on **Saturdays** from **8am** to **1pm**. We will be working up to two nights per week between **8pm** and **5am**.

Residents will be notified if work needs to be completed outside of these standard hours.

How will the work affect you?

Work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier tasks in the earliest part of the shift where possible, using non-tonal reversing alarms on heavy vehicles and switching off plant equipment when not in use.

During construction, the east and westbound bus stops on the western side of Derby Street will be temporarily closed from **Thursday 3 October** to ensure the safety of workers and pedestrians. The nearest bus stops are marked on the map.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe for road workers, motorists and pedestrians. During construction some street parking on Derby Street will be temporarily unavailable. Access through the work site will always be maintained.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and traffic signs. Motorists may experience minor delays due to changed traffic conditions. For the latest traffic updates, you can call 132 701, visit livetraffic.com or download the Live Traffic NSW App.
