## Start of work on Erskine Park Road, Erskine Park from Monday 5th November

The Australian Government is funding a \$200 million Local Roads Package as part of the Western Sydney Infrastructure Plan. Funding has now been allocated for Penrith City Council to improve road safety and traffic flow efficiency at key intersections along Erskine Park Road.

Erskine Park Road will be widened to a four lane dual carriageway between Bennett Road and Explorers Way to join the existing four lane sections towards the M4 Motorway and Swallow Drive. Four intersections will be up upgraded along Erskine Park Road:

- Erskine Park Road and Bennett Road installation of new traffic signals
- Erskine Park Road and Peppertree Drive upgrade to a new seagull intersection
- Erskine Park Road and Coonawarra Drive upgrade to a new seagull intersection
- Erskine Park Road and Explorers Way installation of new traffic signals

New shared user paths will be constructed between Coonawarra Drive and Illawarra Drive.

Penrith City Council invited comments from the community and stakeholders on the proposed project in November 2016. We would like to thank everyone who took the time to consider our proposal and provide feedback.

Work will include tree and vegetation removal, earthworks and stockpiling, and utilities adjustments and relocation. A map on the following page shows the area of the works.

We will be working between **7.00am** and **6.00pm** from **Monday** to **Friday** and between **8.00am** and **1.00pm** on **Saturday** and expect to complete the work in **early 2020** (weather permitting). Any work outside these times will be communicated to you.

## How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. Every effort will be made to minimise noise by arranging the work in stages at different locations, completing noisier activities during the day and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

## Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe for road workers, motorists and pedestrians. Please keep to the speed limits, and follow the direction of traffic controllers and traffic signs. Motorists may experience minor delays due to changed traffic conditions.
