# The Northern Road and Derby Street Intersection Upgrade, Kingswood

The Australian Government is funding a \$200 million Local Roads Package as part of the Western Sydney Infrastructure Plan. Funding has been allocated for Penrith City Council to improve road safety and traffic flow efficiency at key intersections along The Northern Road.

Works are progressing as per schedule to upgrade the intersection at The Northern Road and Derby Street, Kingswood.

Some property and initial traffic adjustment works have been completed.

## Night Work

Work will commence from **Saturday 16**, **November** and will be ongoing through to **Thursday 19**, **December 2019**.

Intermittent night work will be required for up to **two nights per week**. Night work is required to be undertaken outside standard construction hours to ensure the safety of workers, pedestrians and motorists, and to minimise impacts to traffic.

All night work is weather dependent and subject to change. The residents will be notified in advance of any changes to the below night work schedule. Night work activities start from **8pm to 5am.**

### Day work

Day work activities will be completed between **7am to 6pm** Monday to Friday and **8am to 1pm** Saturday Residents will be notified if work needs to be completed outside of these standard hours.

#### How will the work affect you?

Work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier tasks in the earliest part of the shift where possible, using non-tonal reversing alarms on heavy vehicles and switching off plant equipment when not in use.

## Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe for road workers, motorists and pedestrians. During construction some street parking on Derby Street will be temporarily unavailable. Access through the work site will always be maintained.
