DOWNLOAD EBOOKS AND AUDIOBOOKS



Your library never closes with OverDrive. You can download free eBooks and audiobooks 24/7 - all you need is your Penrith Library card, password and internet access. OverDrive is our eBook and audiobook catalogue, which you can use to borrow directly onto your own device.

If you are accessing the OverDrive catalogue on the computer, type in the web address penrith. overdrive.com into your browser. Or if you're using a smart device, download the OverDrive app from the Apple Store or Google Play.

You can access eBooks and audiobooks instantly or download them to your device to enjoy offline while travelling. Borrowed items are returned automatically for you, so you'll never receive an overdue fine.

New titles are added weekly, so you'll always be able to choose from latest releases and all-time favourites, like the Harry Potter series. OverDrive also has a huge range of titles that are on the



Premier's Reading Challenge list, as well as picture books and graded readers suitable for younger readers.

- 1. Browse: you can click on subjects or collections, or you can search for your favourite books and authors.
- 2. Borrow: use your Penrith Library card number and your date of birth as your password.
- Download: the items you borrow are downloaded directly onto your device.
- 4. Enjoy: Relax, read and enjoy.

ORIGAMI AND CALLIGRAPHY BOOKMARK MAKING WORKSHOP


with Midori Furze, Tuesday 11 July
